Polly Woodside is one of Melbourne's iconic attractions and a tangible remainder of Australia's rich maritime history.

Built in 1885 in Belfast, Ireland she sailed 1.5 million kilometers around the globe during her working life and is today one of the world's most significant tall ships and one of the few deep-water tall sailing ships remaining in the world.

"Sold" for one cent to the National Trust in 1968 she has been lovingly restored by volunteers and is now docked at South Wharf, Melbourne and is undoubtedly a unique venue for any function.

With a deck large enough to host a cocktail party of 150 guests and a boardwalk with space for another 150 this original venue is unparalleled.

From the time you step aboard, you will be experiencing a unique occasion to remember. The panoramic views along the Yarra River combined with the atmosphere of this historic vessel ensure a spectacular venue for your function or event.
